The Right Honourable Paul Martin served as the 21st Prime Minister of Canada from 2003 to 2006, as federal Minister of Finance from 1993 to 2002, and as the Member of Parliament for LaSalle-Émard in Montreal, Quebec, for the period 1988 to 2008. He is the founder of the Martin Aboriginal Education Initiative, which aims at reducing

the Aboriginal youth dropout rate and increasing the number of Aboriginal students attending post-secondary institutions. Along with his son David, Mr. Martin also established the Capital for Aboriginal Prosperity and Entrepreneurship Fund, whose investments seek to further a culture of economic independence, ownership and entrepreneurship among both on- and off-reserve Aboriginal peoples through the creation and growth of successful businesses.
